The referral from your GP will have been reviewed and triaged by the Cardiology team to grade your clinical priority based on the information in the referral.

If you are concerned that your condition or symptoms are deteriorating since you were referred to us, please contact your GP, they will ask for you to detail the changes in your condition/symptoms since seeing them last. If appropriate this will be passed to the clinical team and they will re-assess your priority.
