## What should I do if my health is deteriorating?

Whilst you are waiting for your appointment or surgery it is important that you maintain a healthy lifestyle. Consider what you can do to improve your health before coming to hospital for your appointment or surgery. Stopping smoking, reducing alcohol consumption, eating a healthy diet and exercising have all been shown to help patients recover more quickly after surgery. Ask your GP practice for further advice about lifestyle support.

If you have any longstanding conditions, such as blood pressure, you should get this reviewed at your GP practice to make sure it remains well controlled. This will help prevent any unnecessary delays should you require further treatment or surgery.
