Guidance for Patients

Common reasons for having diagnostic examination of the uterus (Hysteroscopy) include:

- Abnormal uterine bleeding to identify causes such as polyps or fibroids within the lining of your womb.
- Postmenopausal bleeding.
- Suspicious lesion seen within the lining of your womb during ultrasound examination.
