

## Ear, Nose and Throat Surgery

### Introduction

Ear Nose and Throat (ENT) surgery is the surgical specialty that focuses on conditions affecting the ears, nose, throat and neck. Medical professionals specialising in this field are trained to diagnose, treat and manage conditions affecting these organs and offer treatment or perform surgery related to the conditions.
