Introduction

Guidance for Patients

Thank you for your patience while awaiting your surgery.

You need to ensure that your body mass index (BMI) does not increase whilst you wait for your surgery. Your surgeon will have discussed your individual BMI target for your surgery to go ahead safely. This information can usually be found in your clinic letter. You can calculate your BMI using this link:

If your BMI does increase to a high level that will make your surgery unsafe, then your procedure may be cancelled on the day of your surgery.
