Excision of Breast

Introduction

You are awaiting an excision of your breast. An excision of your breast is carried out under general anaesthetic in theatre. Your operation is usually carried out as a day case.

Guidance for Patients

Whilst waiting for your operation you may need a further follow up appointment for consenting and to measure for implants (if you are having these at the time of surgery). You will also have your final discussion regarding your operation. Whilst we apologise that you are may be waiting for your operation this will not change your overall outcome as patients are clinically prioritised.

What should I do if my health is deteriorating?

If your symptoms worsen please try all methods above. If your general health worsens you may need to seek advice from your GP. If you feel you no longer need or wish to proceed with your surgery please contact our secretaries who will take you off the waiting list.

However if you are waiting for an operation and your symptoms change you should contact the Breast Care Nurses.
